Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.57 dated 12.07.2024, under Sections 118(1), 351, 3(5), 115(2) of BNS, 2023 (later on added Section 109 of BNS), registered at Police Station Julkan, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 21.11.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sham Lal, has stated that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
