1. The respondent-claimants had filed the claim petition under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicle Act which was partly accepted and the amount of Rs.2,49,000/- was ordered to be paid to the claimants. The claim petition was filed in the year 1991 and the award was passed on 17.04.1992. Against the said order, the appellants had filed the present appeal.

2. The present case is a partly burnt case and from the available record, it is apparent that no stay is there in favour of the appellants.

3. None has appeared on behalf of the respondent-claimants and apparently they are satisfied with the award.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present appeal is disposed of at this stage but liberty is granted to the appellants/respondents to revive the case, in case, any cause of action survives.
