Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a *mandamus* upon the respondent no.1, to decided the representation dated 05.08.2024, (Annexure P-4) moved by the present petitioner, wherethrough a request has been made to pass an Award in Claim Application bearing No.UDYAM-HR-03-0009440/S/00001, dated 01.04.2022, in which the arbitration proceedings vide Arbitration Case No.3959/2022, has already been completed.
2. This Court vide order dated 17.02.2025, passed the following order:-

“Learned State counsel is directed to have instructions from respondent No.1, with regard to time required to pass an award in the petitioner’s case, which is pending adjudication.

Purely in the interest of justice, the case is adjourned to 27.02.2025.

To be shown in the urgent list.

It is made clear that on the next date of hearing, no request for an adjournment on behalf of either of the parties concerned, shall be entertained.”

3. Today, learned State counsel, after having instructions from the quarters concerned, submits that infact petitioner's two applications are pending, one of them is going to be decided today itself, whereas the application (*supra*) *qua* which *mandamus* has been sought, will be decided by the authority concerned, within a period of one month from today.

4. In view of the above submission, at this stage, this Court is of the view that no further *mandamus* is required to be passed, in the instant petition, therefore, the same is ordered to be **closed**.

5. **Disposed of** accordingly.
