



*effected between the parties and he also relies upon the judgment of Co-ordinate Bench of this Court passed in CRM-M-17277-2014 titled as **Krishan Kumar Vs. State of Haryana** decided on 21.12.2017 and judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court passed in **State of Madhya Pradesh Vs. Methaab 2015(1) RCR Criminal 1008** and submits that once prima facie, the offence under Section 304-A of IPC is not made out, there can be no embargo in quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise. He further contends that quashing of FIR(supra) would not hinge upon the public interest or substantial justice.*

Service is already complete.

Adjourned to 21.02.2025.

In the meantime, Parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within a period of two weeks or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of the compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 21.02.2025.

A copy of this order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.”

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 46, Ramgopal and another Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh 2021 SCC OnLine SC 834** and **Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63** and Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (CrL) 1052**, this petition

is allowed and judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 15.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) stemming from FIR No.135 dated 21.08.2012 under Section 304-A of IPC registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same are quashed/set aside, qua the petitioner.
