Prayer in the present petition is for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent(s) for not complying with the order dated 09.8.2024 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA-612-2023 titled as "Harpreet Kaur vs. State of Haryana and others", vide which the appeal was allowed and the judgment dated 15.2.2023 passed by the learned Single Judge was set aside and the respondents were directed to give appointment letter to the petitioner forthwith.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that the order dated 09.8.2024 (Annexure P-2) has been complied with by the respondents.



Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from Shri Sukhpal Singh, Senior Assistant O/o Education Recruitment Board, Punjab, submits that necessary compliance has been made, while issuing appointment letter to the petitioner dated 21.5.2025; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid appointment letter dated 21.5.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner(s). Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.
