1. The only grievance of the petitioner, as raised before this Court by filing the instant writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is that the property which has been ordered to be attached in pursuance of the Award dated 03.08.2023 (Annexure P-4), belongs to him, whereas respondent no.3-Society, has now no concern with such property. He further seeks quashing of proclamation of Sale notice dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) issued by respondent no.1.

2. He fairly concedes that he never approached respondent no.1-Permanent Lok Adalat concerned, to seek clarification to the Award/order of attachment.

3. In view of the above, the petitioner is, hereby, relegated to the respondent No.1-Permanent Lok Adalat, for seeking the relief, as has been sought through the instant writ petition, by filing an apt motion.

4. In case such motion is moved by the petitioner, within a period of seven days from today, respondent no.1-Permanent Lok Adalat, shall make its all endeavours to decide the same most expeditiously preferably within a period of one month, thereafter, after hearing all the parties concerned.

5. The execution proceedings, shall be carried out only after decision of the such motion, which is to be moved by the petitioner.

7. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
