SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Rejoinder on behalf of the petitioner, to the written reply filed by respondent No.4, has been filed in Court today alongwith certain requisite Annexures. The same is taken on record.

2. Post the order of remand pronounced by this Court on 11.09.2023 in *CWP No.13913 of 2023*, it is alleged that purportedly some encroachments have been made on the subject land(s), and, for restraining the making of such purported encroachments, over the subject land(s), the instant petition has been filed.

3. Thus, therebys, the present petitioner seeks an interim direction being passed upon the alleged encroachers concerned, for theirs not further proceeding to make such purported encroachments over the subject lands. However, the said direction may have been passed only when the



proceedings drawn before the competent statutory authorities rather had fully terminated, but since the proceedings drawn before the competent statutory authorities are still subjudiced them. As such relief (supra) can be claimed only before the authorities wherebefore the instant *lis* is subjudice and not before this Court.

4. Consequently, finding no merit in the instant writ petition, thus the same is dismissed, but with liberty to the present petitioner to seek the present writ relief from the Remandee Court concerned.

5. The instant petition stands disposed of accordingly.
