Learned State counsel on instructions submits that work of fixation of pillars on the land in question which is allegedly the subject matter of river action shall be concluded by 30.09.2025 in pursuance of a work order allocated for the said purpose.

In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

Rule discharged.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition in case the respondents fail to abide by the aforesaid undertaking and in that eventuality salary of both the respondents shall remain attached till the compliance is made and the actual physical possession is delivered to the Gram Panchayat, Toki, Sonipat.
