1. By this common order, three writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as all these petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners concedes that all the benefits for which the petitioners were entitled for, have already been released to them but they intend to claim the interest on the arrears which have been paid to them by filing appropriate representation before the authorities concerned.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any such claim/representation is received at the hands of the petitioners, the same will be considered and appropriate speaking order on the said representation will be passed by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation/claim and in case, it is found that the petitioners are entitled for any relief, the same will be granted to them otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioners, which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
