1. Present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* seeking quashing of the order dated 11.03.2022 (Annexure P-7), vide which services of the petitioner were dispensed with.
2. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 & 3 has produced a copy of the office order dated 04.03.2025 before this Court, which is taken on record.

He submits that the competent authority, by giving relaxation of qualification required for the post of Peon, allowed the petitioner to continue on the same post. As such, the impugned order dated 11.03.2022 (Annexure P-7) has become inoperative and the present petition has become as infructuous.

3. In view of the above, instant petition is disposed of having been rendered as infructuous.

4. However, it is made clear that if anything survives in the present petition, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the same.

5. All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
