1. This is an application filed under Section 151 CPC for taking on record Annexures P-73 and P-74 and for their consideration towards final disposal of main revision petition.
2. For the reasons stated in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit, the present application is allowed.

1. This is an application under Section 151 CPC for preponement



of the date of hearing in the main case from 04.11.2025 to an early date as the matter has been settled between the parties.

2. For the reasons stated in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit, the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in main revision petition is preponed from 04.11.2025 to today and is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

1. On 03.07.2025, this Court had passed the following order:-

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for respondent no.1 have submitted that although the mediation has failed but the parties wish to make second attempt for resolving the matter and have jointly prayed that the matter be referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Accordingly, the matter is referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and parties are directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 04.08.2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel



for contesting respondent No.1 have jointly submitted that the matter has been amicably settled before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the detailed terms and conditions have been duly mentioned in the settlement/compromise deed dated 13.08.2025. It is submitted that the terms and conditions of the said settlement be read as a part of the present order and have further submitted that all the parties concerned would be bound by the said terms and conditions. It is further submitted that the settlement has been arrived at before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 13.08.2025 without any pressure or coercion.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances and also the joint prayer made on behalf of the petitioners as well as respondent No.1, the present revision petition is disposed of in terms of the settlement arrived at on 13.08.2025 before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court bearing Mediation case No.655 of 2025, which has been annexed along with the present paper book. As undertaken before this Court, all the parties concerned would be bound by the terms and conditions of the said settlement which has been arrived at without any undue pressure or coercion.

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
