**RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)**

1. Present petition has been filed praying for directing respondent No.2 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate security/police protection to the petitioners and also directing respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners. Further prayer has been made for directing respondents No.2 & 3 not to allow/let respondents No.4 to 7 or anybody else to interfere with the liberty and lives of the petitioners or to harass them in any manner against the wishes of petitioners or to cause any detriment to the petitioners in any manner, as petitioners are living in live-in-relationship.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No.2 is major and petitioner No.1 is minor being 17 years and 09 months of age. He has submitted that both the petitioners are living with each other in a live-in-relationship with their own free will and they will



solemnize their marriage after attaining marriageable age by petitioner No.1 (minor). He has further submitted that the petitioners apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 7. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 06.06.2025 (Annexure P-3) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, Punjab (respondent No.2).

3. Notice of motion to official respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. J. S. Arora, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

5. Mr. Bhagat S. Ghuman, Advocate has appeared and filed his vakalatnama on behalf of respondents No.4 to 7 today in the Court and the same is taken on record. He has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

6. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, the present petition stands disposed of. Petitioner No.1 would approach respondent No.2, i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, Punjab within two days from today. However respondent No.2, i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa is directed to ensure that petitioner No.1, whose mobile number is 7888331960, is admitted to Protection Home, Mansa and provide her protection till she attains the age of majority and if the need be, necessary protection would also be granted to both the petitioners.
