JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 30.04.1999 (Annexure P-10) and direction to respondents to extend benefit of pension.
2. The respondents are claiming that mere payment of gratuity does not make petitioner a regular employee and eligible for pension. He was never regularised, thus, there is no question of pension.
3. Mr. Tarun Seth, Advocate submits that petitioner and his wife have passed away.
4. Mr. Ajit Singh, Legal Aid Counsel expressed his inability to controvert the aforesaid factual and legal position.
5. Dismissed.
