This petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 praying for the direction to respondent No.1 to 3 to conduct a fair, proper, and impartial investigation in FIR No. 183, dated 12.09.2024, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B, IPC, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District-Patiala (Annexure P-1), as the local police is not conducting a fair, proper, and impartial investigation.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to Deputy Inspector General of Police, Punjab, Range Patiala to decide the representations dated 31.03.2025 and 13.03.2025 (Annexure P-3 and P-4) within a time bound manner.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, Deputy Inspector General of Police, Punjab, Range Patiala is directed to consider and decide the representations dated 31.03.2025 and 13.03.2025 (Annexure P-3 and P-4) by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within three days thereafter.
5. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
