SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. Present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, for directing learned District Judge, Kapurthala to decide the Civil Appeal No.48 of 2024 which is pending for 13.08.2025, expeditiously.

2. A perusal of the file shows that above referred civil appeal is at the stage of arguments since 10.04.2024 and the arguments in the appeal have not been addressed by the parties till date.

3. On 04.07.2025, the following order was passed by learned District Judge, Kapurthala:-

“The case was listed for arguments. However, on request of learned counsels for parties case stands adjourned to 13.8.2025 for arguments with connected matter.”
