KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant writ petition, as cast under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a Mandamus upon respondent No.1, to regularize the service of petitioners as Sweeper, and grant them other reliefs, as embodied in the writ petition.

2. At the outset, upon being confronted, as to why, the petitioners have straightaway rushed to this Court for redressal of their grievance, without approaching the competent authority, learned counsel for the petitioners fails to satisfy this Court. Therefore, this Court finds no reason to issue the asked for Mandamus, at this stage.

3. In view of the above, the instant writ petition, being a misconceived motion, is hereby **dismissed**. However, liberty is reserved to the petitioners to approach the competent authority as regards their grievance, by way of a comprehensive representation, at the first instance.
