1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to fix the pay of the petitioner @ Rs.42,600/- per month w.e.f. 01.10.2022 as she is admittedly working in the Department as Guest Faculty (English) since the Session 2008.

2. Learned counsel submits that regarding the claim as raised in the present petition, a representation dated 02.01.2023, Annexure P-6, has been submitted through e-mail, however, the same has yet not evoked any response. He thus, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 02.01.2023, within a period of 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to her and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to her interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
