Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case any representation is received at the hands of the appellants, the same will be decided in accordance with law after hearing all the parties concerned and an appropriate speaking order will be passed. In case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the appellants, the same will be granted otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the appellants will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed by the authorities concerned.

7. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent-State, present appeal may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file an appropriate representation with the respondents.

8. Ordered accordingly.

9. Civil miscellaneous application pending, if any is also disposed of.
