The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant/release all the benefits to the petitioner as per Clause 11 of the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016 (amended from time to time) along with eighteen per cent interest per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before respondents. At this stage, petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide his legal notice, dated 13.07.2024, Annexure P-4, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that the legal notice, dated 13.07.2024,

will be decided by respondent no.2/Director General, Elementary School Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
