The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.09, dated 17.01.2021, registered under Section 420 IPC and under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (subsequently deleted and replaced with Section 7-A of the Prevention of Corruption(Amendment) Act, at Police Station City-2, Malerkotla, District Sangrur and subsequently under Section 120-B IPC (added at the time of issuance of summoning orders under Section 319 Cr.P.C).

Admittedly, the petitioner was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. as an additional accused in a criminal case arising from the aforesaid FIR. The case is now fixed for petitioner's appearance on 03.07.2025.

The learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, has failed to disclose the reasons for custodial interrogation of the petitioner particularly when he was not named as an accused in the final report submitted by the Police.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to enter appearance before the Court on 03.07.2025.

In the meantime, the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
