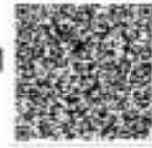

HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the official respondents to allow the petitioner to harvest the standing eucalyptus trees/crops, which were sown by him during the validity of the lease of the agricultural land measuring 11 Acres.

1.1 A further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 – Deputy Commissioner, Hoshiarpur, to take necessary action on the petitioner's representation dated 08.07.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner

would be satisfied at this stage if time bound directions are issued to respondent No.2 – Deputy Commissioner, Hoshiarpur, to decide the petitioner’s representation dated 08.07.2025 (Annexure P-2).

3. Learned State counsel submits that the aforesaid representation dated 08.07.2025 (Annexure P-2) shall be considered and decided by the Deputy Commissioner, Hoshiarpur/competent authority, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties as well as to the Forest Department, within a period of six weeks from today, in accordance with law.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

5. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
