The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to issue appointment letter to the petitioner for the post of Welder (Gas & Electric) Instructor Theory pursuant to advertisement 12/2019.

2. Learned State counsel has received instructions from the Department vide memo dated 24.09.2025, a copy whereof is retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'. It is to the following effect:

In the meantime, with regard to the candidature of the petitioner, a complaint was received from Sh. Manjeet claiming that the experience annexed by the petitioner is not genuine and he further contended that the firm mentioned by the petitioner is closed since year 2020. On the basis of the complaint, physical Document Verification committee was constituted for verifying the documents of the petitioner and the Principal, Government Industrial Training Institute, Rohtak, was ordered to submit his report to the Directorate after physically verifying the experience certificate of the petitioner by way of visiting the address of Sh. Gurukripa Industries, Rudrapur, Uttarakhand.



The Principal, Government Industrial Training Institute, Rohtak, submitted his report in the report he stated that the committee visited Shri Gurukripa Industries, Rudrapur, Uttarakhand, and found that there was no industry by that name there. Therefore, the experience certificate of the petitioner was not found genuine. Therefore, candidature of the petitioner was proposed to be cancelled due to the candidate's record being unproven and doubtful.

She further contends that an appropriate order regarding the petitioner's candidature will be passed within ten days and conveyed to him as well.

3. In view thereof, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order aforementioned in case he is aggrieved.
