By this common order, 06 aforementioned cases i.e. 03 Regular Second Appeal bearing RSA Nos. 2783, 3439 & 3736-2018 and 03 Civil Revisions bearing CR Nos. 4006, 4007 and 3956-2018, are being disposed of as similar facts are involved therein.

At the very outset, by placing on record 03 separate copies of order dated 26.04.2023 passed by the learned Executing Court, Guhla, in (i) EXE/08/2019 (in RSA-2783-2018 and CR-4006-2018); (ii) order dated 03.05.2023 passed in EXE/10/2019 (in RSA-3439-2018 and CR-4007-2018); and (iii) order dated 26.04.2023 passed in EXE/14/2019 (in RSA-3736-2018 and CR-3956-2018), learned counsel for plaintiff-respondents No. 1 and 2/Decree-Holders (in all the 06 cases) submits that nothing survives in all the cases as, the decree stands fully satisfied before the learned Executing Court; and the aforesaid Execution Petition(s) filed by the plaintiff/respondents No. 1 and 2/Decree-Holders were dismissed as withdrawn being fully satisfied.



Learned counsel for the appellant-defendant No.3 (in all second appeals) and learned counsel for the petitioners (in all revision petitions) have not been able to controvert the aforesaid submissions of learned counsel for respondents No. 1 and 2/plaintiffs/Decree-Holders.

In view of the above, all the aforementioned 06 cases i.e. 03 second appeals bearing RSA Nos. 2783, 3439 & 3736-2018; and 03 Civil Revisions bearing CR Nos. 4006, 4007 and 3956-2018 are **disposed of**, accordingly.
