MAIN CASE

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that for grant of
regular electricity connection, the petitioner may apply in terms of Supply
Code 2024, notified on 14.11.2024 by the Punjab State Regulatory
Commission. He further submits that the benefit of aforementioned Supply
Code, which relates to the abandoned colonies, applies to one and all

including the petitioner as well, viz., all the residents of Sector-123, T-Block, New Sunny Enclave, SAS Nagar (Mohali). He further assures that as and when an application is moved in terms of the aforementioned Supply Code alongwith the requisite charges, the same shall be considered and dealt with expeditiously.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage.

[3] **Disposed off** accordingly.

[4] Rule stands discharged.

[5] However, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach again in case any cause still survives.
