Prayer in this application is for condonation of delay of 159 days in filing the appeal.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed. Delay of 159 days in filing the appeal stands condoned.

1. The present appeal has been filed against the impugned judgment dated 28.09.2022, whereby the complaint filed by the appellant under Section 340 Cr.P.C., 1973, was dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the appellant vehemently argued that there was cogent and corroborative evidence to show that the respondent had forged documents during the proceedings before the trial Court, and thus,

the Court below erred in not appreciating the same while dismissing the complaint.

3. However, the counsel for the appellant could not deny the fact that the appellant and respondent have already been divorced, and there is no challenge to the said proceedings wherein the alleged forged documents were produced.

4. Considering the factual matrix that the parties have already parted ways, and more so, the proceedings under Section 340 Cr.P.C. are primarily between the Court and the person who has forged or misled the Court, I find no ground to proceed further in the matter. Accordingly, the present appeal stands dismissed.
