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**JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)**

The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the State to conduct a further investigation/re-investigation in FIR No.13 dated 05.01.2023 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B IPC and Section 24 of the Emigration Act at Police Station Assandh.

The brief facts of the case are that the aforementioned FIR was registered against five persons namely, Suresh Resha, Deepika Sharma, Aakash Sharma, Sanjay and Amit Yadav. The report under Section 173(2) Cr.PC has been submitted only against two persons. It is the case of the petitioner that the three persons who have been left out have been wrongly exonerated and therefore, a further investigation should take place.

On the other hand, the learned State Counsel contends that on an investigation being conducted, the report under Section 173(2) Cr.PC was submitted only against two accused and if the complainant is aggrieved thereof, he has the remedy of moving an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. for summoning those accused who have been exonerated.

In view of the contentions raised, I find that the question of issuance of directions under Section 482 Cr.PC to conduct a further investigation/re-investigation at this stage does not arise once the prosecution evidence is also being recorded.

Needless to say, the complainant is at liberty to move an application under Section 319 Cr.PC seek the summoning of those accused who were exonerated. If such application is made, the Trial Court shall decide the same within a period of 04 weeks of moving such application.
