**ALOK JAIN, J. (Oral)**

1. By way of instant appeal, appellant has assailed the impugned order dated 13.03.2025, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Mansa, in case FIR No.11 dated 28.02.2025 under Sections 299, 61 (2) of the BNS and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Joga, District Mansa (Annexure P-1) vide which the anticipatory bail of the appellant had been dismissed.

2. Vide order dated 08.04.2025, the Coordinate Bench while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the appellant to

join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Buta Singh, submits that the appellant has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

4. In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 08.04.2025 granting interim anticipatory bail to the appellant, is made absolute. However, the appellant shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.

5. However, nothing stated above shall be construed as a final expression of opinion on the merits of the case and this order shall not be considered as parity qua any other co-accused.

6. It is made clear that, in case, the appellant is found involved in any such activity once again, the present concession so granted shall automatically stand vacated.
