This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 04.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Appellate Authority, Jalandhar, vide which the application filed by the respondent for adjudicating the mesne profit has been allowed.
