**NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)**

1. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to assign the investigation of case FIR No.92, dated 16.11.2022, under Sections 376(2)(n), 384, 506 IPC, registered at Women Police Station, Panchkula, District Panchkula (Annexure P-1), to some independent Investigating Agency other than the local police of District Panchkula, so that proper, fair, independent and impartial investigation may be conducted.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 24.02.2025, the following order was passed:-

“Learned State counsel submits that the untraced report has been presented before the trial Court on 28.10.2024 and notice to the complainant was issued for 07.12.2024. Thereafter, the matter has been adjourned for 03.05.2025.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not present.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 06.08.2025.”

3. Learned State counsel submits that since the untraced report has already been presented before the trial Court, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner can pursue her remedy before the trial Court.

4. No one was present on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing. Even today, position is the same.

5. Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

6. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file protest petition before the trial Court, if so aggrieved.
