1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.22, dated 17.04.2025, under Section 308(2) of B.N.S, 2023 registered at Police Station Sector 19 Chandigarh (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.05.2025 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 14.05.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner
