1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 11.07.2024 registered under Section 376 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012 at Women Police Station, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Tripta Sood, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (Crime Against Women), Amritsar City, on behalf of the respondent-State, has been filed in the Court which is taken on record.
