HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Learned State counsel on instructions from Sh. Parminder Singh, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot submits that a speaking order with respect to the recoveries being effected from the petitioner shall be passed within two weeks from today. Learned State counsel further assures that even interest on the delayed disbursal of pensionary benefits shall be released within two weeks thereafter.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
