Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.690 dated 10.12.2024 registered under Sections 61 of Excise Act at Police Station Old Industrial Panipat, District Panipat.

2. The petitioner was granted concession of interim bail by this Court with direction to join investigation on the last date of hearing.

3. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that by virtue of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined investigation with the police.

4. Reply filed on behalf of the State by way of affidavit of Satish Kumar, DSP, HQ, Panipat is ordered to be taken on record. State counsel on instructions from ASI Tinku has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and he further made statement in terms of para

4 of the aforesaid reply submitted on behalf of the State to the effect that the petitioner is not required any longer for purpose of further investigation or custodial interrogation. It is also brought to the notice of this Court that the recoveries were also effected in this case from the spot.

5. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 14.1.2025 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. However, it is made clear that the petitioner is to join further investigation as and when called to do so by I.O./SHO concerned, in future.
