AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

Petitioner Lovejeet Kaur filed petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of suitable directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for free and fair investigation in FIR No.75 dated 16.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Section 65 (1) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala with further prayer that inquiry be got conducted from a senior police official as son of petitioner has been falsely implicated at the instance of private respondent Nos.6 and 7.

Status report has been filed in which it is submitted that after proper investigation of the case, challan is already presented on 15.01.2025. Since accused, in this FIR, could not be arrested, proclamation proceedings have been initiated against him. It is pointed out that petitioner and other family members are trying to save the accused by claiming that victim is of unsound mind. It is further submitted that during investigation and medical examination of the victim, there is nothing to show that she is

having any mental problem or abnormality. Proper and fair investigation was carried out as per law.

In view of the aforesaid factual position, it is clear that after completion of investigation, challan is already presented in FIR No.75 dated 16.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 65 (1) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1). Main accused who is son of petitioner is yet to be arrested. Since no further direction is required to be passed, present petition stands disposed of in view of the status report.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
