Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.63 dated 20.05.2024 under Sections 406/420/120-B of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 06.11.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions has stated that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
