This review application has been filed by the petitioner alleging that there is palpable error, which has crept in final order dated 12.12.2024 passed in a bunch of petitions, including CWP-21653-2024 filed by applicant/petitioner.

After having heard learned counsel for rival parties, it appears that CWP-21653-2024 had been disposed of by inadvertence in a bunch of petitions, which related to challenge to show cause notice for declaration of fraud issued prior to passing of judgment by Apex Court in **State Bank of India Vs. Rajesh Aggarwal, 2023 (6) SCC 1** (decided on 27.03.2023) and consequential FIR. CWP-21653-2024, however, relates to subsequent show cause notice dated 17.11.2023 (Annexure P-8) for declaration of fraud. Therefore, the issue in CWP-21653-2024 was diverse to the issue involved in bunch of petitions, which were disposed of vide final order dated 12.12.2024.

In view of above, it appears that palpable error has occurred in passing of final order dated 12.12.2024 qua CWP-21653-2024, which is sought to be re-called by way of instant review application.

Accordingly, **RA-CW-37-2025** stands allowed.

CWP-21653-2024 is restored to its original number and is ordered to be listed as per roster.
