Prayer made in the instant writ petition is for directing the Anomaly Committee which may be constituted to provide an opportunity of hearing or interaction to the petitioner regarding allowances in the wake of recommendations of Seventh Pay Commission.

2 Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that so far as the substantive prayers made in the instant writ petition are concerned, the same stand answered and the grievances stand redressed to

the said extent, however, he prays that the respondents should have constituted an Alternative Suitable Institutional Participative Mechanism to provide a grievance redressal to the employees. He contends that he would be satisfied at this juncture, in case the respondents may consider the instant writ petition as a representation and take appropriate steps towards creation of such Forum and activation thereof if such Forum already exists.
