1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents to allow the gram panchayat to function in a proper manner in terms of resolution passed by it and to make payments to necessary firms from which the material has been purchased for conducting development work in the village.
