The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.57, dated 22.06.2024 under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act, later on added 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).

2. Vide order dated 20.12.2024 passed by this Court, the arrest of the petitioner was stayed and he was directed to join the investigation before the I.O, however, the petitioner did not join the investigation. Consequently, vide order dated 06.02.2025, he was again directed to appear before the I.O at 10:00 AM on 11.02.2025 to join the investigation and was also directed to co-operate with the Investigating Agency. However, learned State counsel has informed the Court that the petitioner has not appeared before the I.O to join the investigation. It is apparent that the petitioner has misused the interim orders dated 20.12.2024 and 06.02.2025 passed by this Court and despite specific

directions issued by this Court, he has not even bothered to appear before the I.O.

3. In view of the above, the present petition deserves to be dismissed.
