2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Hardeep Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQ, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh, on behalf of the respondent-State, filed in the Registry is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 04.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation. He further submits that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant vide compromise deed dated 18.08.2025 and affidavit dated 18.08.2025 of the complainant (Annexures P-11 & P-12).

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

5. Learned counsel for the complainant also admits the factum of compromise arrived at between the parties.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim relief granted to the petitioner vide order dated 04.03.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
