1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the respondent has refunded the entire amount deposited by the petitioner without any deduction by cancelling the allotment of plot in the name of the petitioner in terms of order dated 10.07.2020, in CWP-18676-2019, therefore, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the Contempt Petition.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent also contends that directions of Hon'ble the Division Bench dated 10.07.2020, in CWP-18676-2019, to refund the entire amount deposited by the petitioner without any deduction after cancelling the allotment in the name of the petitioner has already been complied with, therefore, no contempt is made out, consequentially the petition be disposed of as not calling for any further orders.
4. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties.
5. Admittedly, order of Hon'ble the Division Bench dated 10.07.2020,

in CWP-18676-2019, has been complied with, nor there is any intentional and willful defiance of the aforementioned order. Resultantly, no further orders are called for. Accordingly, the Contempt Petition is dismissed. Rule discharged.
