1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to decide his representations dated 18.02.2025 (Annexures P-12 and P-13) and to take legal action against the accused persons.

2. Learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that representations were given on 18.02.2025 (Annexures P-12 and P-13) to the respondents No.2 & 3, however, it had failed to yield any response. It has been submitted that the official respondents were under a legal obligation to pass an appropriate order on his complaints/representations. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Yamuna Nagar, to look into the representations dated 18.02.2025 (Annexures P-12 and P-13) of the petitioner and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.



4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Ravish Kaushik, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of and respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, District Yamuna Nagar, is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take appropriate steps, if any required, under the provisions of law. However, if respondent No.2 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the representations dated 18.02.2025 (Annexures P-12 and P-13), then the petitioner shall be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the Supreme Court in *Lalita Kumari Versus Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors., 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979*.
