KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for directing the respondents concerned, for restoration of his agricultural power connection which was disconnected on 19.12.2024.
2. A perusal of the instant petition reflects that, in fact it is a misconceived motion, inasmuch as, despite the petitioner being seized of an alternate and efficacious statutory remedy for redressal of his grievance before the Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum concerned, yet he has sidetracked the said remedy and have straightway accessed this Court, through instituting the present petition.
3. Faced with the above difficulty, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the instant petition,

with liberty to, either assail the order passed by the Civil Court, wherethrough his stay has been vacated or to approach the Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum concerned, for redressal of his grievance.

4. **Dismissed as withdraw** with the aforesaid liberty.
