1. This petition seeking for quashing of FIR No.57 dated 23.04.2021, under Sections 188 of IPC, Section 51 Disaster Management Act, 2005 & 3 Epidemic Diseases Act 1897, PS Division No.2, Pathankot has been moved at a stage when the trial before the learned trial Court has already been concluded and the petitioner on the basis of his confessional statement has been convicted.

2. Admittedly against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence an appeal has been preferred by the petitioner.
