**HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)**

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Kuldeep Singh, Assistant Director, DHE, Haryana, who is present in Court, submits that all the consequential / retiral benefits including the arrears alongwith interest @ 6% per annum, in terms of order dated 06.12.2024 (Annexure R-1), shall be released in favour of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /

concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
