Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) for directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 05.06.2024 and take action against the private respondents No.4 to 10 in FIR No. 244 dated 14.08.2021, under Sections 452, 325, 323, 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural (P-1).

2. Although there is no formal notice of motion, but learned State counsel, on instructions from SHO Kulwinder Singh, has apprised this Court that there are total seven accused in the above FIR and all have been arrested; but later on granted bail. He has also apprised that report under Section 173 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Section 193 of BNSS,2023 is ready and likely to be presented before the Court of competent jurisdiction shortly.



3. In view of the above development, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition “at this stage”.

4. Disposed off accordingly.

5. Above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case, in any manner.

6. Needless to say that necessary steps be taken by the quarter concerned expeditiously, in accordance with law.
