JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 24.02.2025 whereby respondent has accepted application of the petitioner seeking voluntary retirement. He is further seeking direction to respondent to permit him to withdraw his application seeking VRS and permit him to remain in service.

2. The petitioner applied for VRS on account of his illness on 14.02.2025. His application came to be allowed by Superintendent of Police, Palwal. He was ordered to retire w.e.f. 31.05.2025 subject to Rule 146 of Haryana Civil Services (General Rules), 2016. He vide application dated 24.04.2025 requested Superintendent of Police, Palwal to permit him to rejoin. He sought permission to withdraw his application seeking

VRS and recalling of VRS order dated 24.02.2025. Inspector General of Police vide order dated 20.05.2025 has asked Superintendent of Police, Palwal to take necessary action in accordance with rules/instructions.

3. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court, on being confronted with communication dated 20.05.2025 to Inspector General of Police to Superintendent of Police, Palwal submits that Superintendent of Police, Palwal would consider petitioner's application and pass appropriate order expeditiously within one week from today.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the petition stands disposed of.
