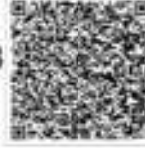

1. In compliance of the order dated 09.01.2025, a status reply by way of affidavit dated 12.01.2025 of SSP, Tarn Taran, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Avtar Singh, submits that the matter was examined by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran and it has been found that the complaint was closed by the officials of Police Station Sadar, District Tarn Taran without seeking medical opinion from the doctors. He further contends that now FIR No.0003 dated 10.01.2025 under Sections 117(2) and 3(5) of BNS, Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran has been registered against Amritpal Singh (respondent No.4), Balraj Singh, Tony and other two unknown accused. He further submits that during the course of investigation, the offences under

Sections 74, 303(2) and 351(2) of BNS have been added in the present case vide DDR No.24 dated 11.01.2025. He next submits that a regular departmental enquiry has been initiated against SI Avtar Singh, SHO P.S. Sadar Tarn Taran & ASI Satnam Singh No.331/TTN PS Sadar Tarn Taran and an appropriate action shall be taken against the erring officials. He further contends that the investigation of the case, i.e. FIR No.0003 dated 10.01.2025 shall be conducted by some gazetted officer.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be issued and the present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
