Sumeet Goel (Oral):

1. The substantive prayer made in the instant petition reads thus:-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the petition may kindly be accepted and necessary directions may kindly be issued to the Ld. Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana to expedite the proceedings of the case having No.COMA/4262/2020 dated 19.03.2020 titled as ‘Satinder Kaur Vs. Bahadur Shah Bhai’ filed under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.”

2. Keeping in view the nature of the prayer made, this Court does not deem it appropriate to call upon respondent-side, at this stage, lest it may further delay culmination of proceedings.
