1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 02.02.2022 passed in CWP-1030-2022.

2. Affidavit of Sandeep Kaur, Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Society, Sangrur, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

3. Affidavit dated 17.07.2024 of respondent No.5 filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.

4. Counsel for the respondents have submitted that the order dated 02.02.2022 passed in CWP-1030-2022 has since been complied with
